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- 1** Subtracting a positive from a negative results in the an even bigger negative

$$-3 - 1 = ?$$

-2	-3	3	-4	4

- 5** Subtracting a positive from a negative results in the an even bigger negative

$$-1 - 4 = ?$$

a	b	c	d	e
-3	-8	-5	8	3

- 6** Subtracting a negative is the same as adding a positive. The first number is also positive, so this results in an even bigger positive.

$$4 - -1 = ?$$

a	b	c	d	e	f
-4	6	4	-3	5	3

$$4 - -3 = ?$$

6	-9	9	-1	1	7
