

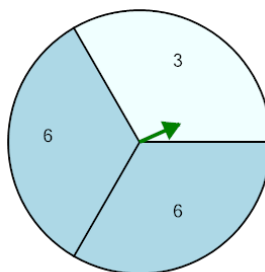

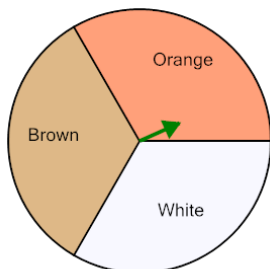


P(3 twice)

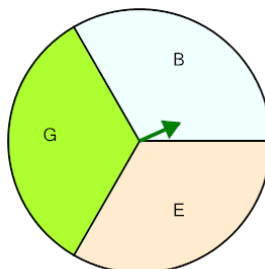


P(Orange twice)

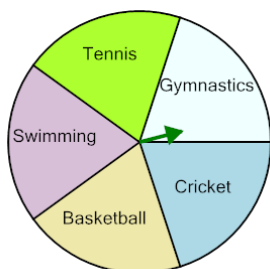


P(G twice)

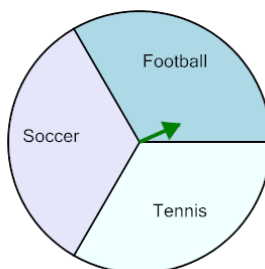


P(Gymnastics twice)

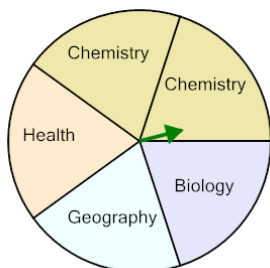


P(Football twice)

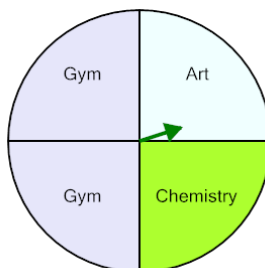


P(Health twice)
